  - a. Option 1: Transfer all current Hatch Fire Department apparatus and equipment to DACFR. Under this option, the Village of Hatch would remain responsible for all costs associated with operating the fire station.
  - b. Option 2: Allow DACFR to consider constructing a new fire station if the Village deeds the property to the County. Under this option, Doña Ana County would assume full responsibility for all costs associated with operating the fire department.

#### Minutes:

Trustee Crist made a motion to approve moving forward with Option 2: allowing Doña Ana County Fire & Rescue (DACFR) to consider constructing a new fire station, contingent upon the Village deeding the property to the County. Under this option, Doña Ana County would assume full responsibility for all costs associated with operating the fire department. Seconded by Trustee Franzoy. Motion carried.
